Welcome! The risen Lord taught His disciples "that the Christ should suffer, and on the third day, rise from the dead" and "that repentance for the forgiveness of sins should be proclaimed in his name to all nations," (Luke 24:46–47). Therefore, Peter preaches repentance and forgiveness to the people of Jerusalem. As he proclaims that Jesus fulfilled all that "God foretold by the mouth of all the prophets" (Acts 3:18), he also convicts the people of their sin because they "delivered over and denied" this Lord Jesus and "killed the Author of life." Yet God "glorified his servant Jesus" and raised Him from the dead (Acts 3:13–15). Peter calls the people to repent, so that their "sins may be blotted out, that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord," (Acts 3:19–20). Through this forgiveness of sins and by faith in this forgiveness, the Father shows His love for us that "we should be called children of God; and so we are," (1 John 3:1). Thus, we hope in Him and are made pure even "as he is pure," because he appeared to take away sins, and in him there is no sin (1 John 3:3, 5).

First Reading

Acts 3:11-21

While he clung to Peter and John, all the people, utterly astounded, ran together to them in the portico called Solomon's. And when Peter saw it he addressed the people: "Men of Israel, why do you wonder at this, or why do you stare at us, as though by our own power or piety we have made him walk?
