Special Voters' Meeting May 4 via Zoom

Because of the increasing economic challenges in the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic, Beautiful Savior has applied for approximately \$48,000 in loan/grant money through the Payroll Protection Program of the recently approved federal CARES Act to help our congregation navigate an expected significant budget shortfall this year.

Although we applied for this grant without voter approval due to time constraints and in an effort to ensure participation in this program, Beautiful Savior will be holding a special voters' meeting at Monday, May 4, to discuss and decide how much of this money (if any) should be used.

Please note that we will not use any of these funds without voter approval. In the eventuality that our voters reject the idea of using these funds, we will simply pay back the money immediately after receiving it.

Updates on BSLC Worship and Activities

The pastors and elders at Beautiful Savior have decided to extend the suspension of our in-person activities, including Bible studies and worship, through Saturday, May 23.

Beautiful Savior tentatively plans to begin live, in-person worship services again Sunday, May 24, but will limit the number of people worshipping at one time to 50 people. Following federal, state and local guidelines, we will seek to combine service with safety. We will offer services at 8:30 and 10 a.m. on Sundays through the summer until further notice as well as 7 p.m. on Wednesdays through Aug. 26, to accommodate our members. Individual small groups also may resume activities at the church on May 24 and following.

We pray that you will continue to follow safety protocol and social distancing guidelines. If you are among vulnerable populations, please exercise caution when deciding to come to church. If you are feeling ill or have any symptoms related to coronavirus, please stay home for the safety and welfare of others!

Are You Dressed for Your Own Pity Party?

“Answer me when I call, O God of my righteousness!” (Psalm 4:1a). This Psalm is a bedtime prayer, and an upset one at that. The psalmist is churning over some interpersonal strife. Whether you are a morning or an evening person, you probably have a time of day when you wear down and grumble because someone’s bugging you and dress for your own pity party.

The psalmist thinks it through. “You have given me relief when I was in distress,” (Psalm 4:1b). He bases his prayer upon God’s help in the past; just so, you, as a follower of Christ, reflect on past interpersonal conflicts that the Spirit of Christ has turned into reconciliation. “Be gracious to me and hear my prayer!” (Psalm 4:1c). Help me as you have helped me.

It’s tough when you can’t sleep because of interpersonal conflict. I know that personally! “Be angry, and do not sin; ponder in your own hearts on your beds and be silent,” (Psalm 4:4). Could it be that I’m a contributor to the interpersonal problem that has me so disgruntled? Should I stop tossing and turning now, give it to God in repentance, and resolve to work toward a solution tomorrow? When I’m on my bed, shouldn’t I look up and be completely honest before God? “Offer right sacrifices, and put your trust in the Lord,” (Psalm 4:5).

So, when you take off your work clothes (or change from one set of PJ’s to the next) and get ready for bed, take off any self-righteousness that shows up as self-pity. “Jesus, Thy blood and righteousness / My beauty are, my glorious dress.” (LSB Hymn 563 v. 1). Then put your head on the pillow with this thought: “In peace I will both lie down and sleep; for you alone, O Lord, make me dwell in safety,” (Psalm 4:8).
